The Regional Marine and Coastal Forum is a framework for direct discussions on West African marine and coastal zone issues between stakeholders from government institutions, international and community organizations, national parliamentarians, the private sector, environmental civil society, professional organizations, research institutes, the media and many others.

It is a place for disseminating and appropriating innovations and successful practices in the conservation of coastal and marine spaces and resources, through interactive exchange sessions.

Hosted every two years by 300 to 400 stakeholders in one of the capital cities of the PRCM countries, the Forum provides an opportunity for broad consultation on crucial conservation issues, with the aim of reaching a strong agreement.

The theme of the 11th edition is: "Conservation, resilience and sustainable development of the West African coastline in the face of global change"

A number of sub-themes will be addressed through plenary sessions and round-table discussions, where conservation experts will deliver high-impact speeches. These include the interaction between science, local knowledge and policy for a sustainable coastline, coastal resilience solutions, the Blue Economy and ocean protection, and youth engagement, among others.
